

Olde Atlanta Club Pool Rules 2017

The pools are for use by residents of Olde Atlanta Club and their guests.

All pool privileges are void if the OAC resident's account is not current.

Guests must be accompanied by a resident.

An OAC member may only admit up to a total of 8 non-resident guests at a time. Residents and their guests are responsible for adhering to all rules and regulations. Trespassers will be removed from the premises.

WHEN GUARDS ARE NOT ON DUTY, IT IS 'SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK'. SWIMMERS UNDER 14 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

1. The OAC Pools are open for use between 6 a.m. and 11 p.m. Lifeguards are on duty from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.
2. The following rules apply within the pool area: No glass of any kind; No running; No diving; No pushing or rough play including "chicken fights" and throwing others into any pool; No loud music; No profanity, improper behavior or vulgar language; No bikes, scooters, skateboards, skates, or roller blades; No hard balls.
3. Proper swim attire must be worn, no cutoffs.
4. **No smoking** in the general pool area. The gazebo is the designated smoking area.
5. **No pets or animals** are allowed in the pool area.
6. **The wading pool is not guarded.** It is intended for minors 3 yrs. and under. **Non-toilet trained individuals must wear a swim diaper.** Minors using this pool require supervision at all times by an adult 18 years or older.
7. **The lower, adult pool, is for ages 18 and over. No one under the age of 18 is permitted.**
8. Lifeguards have full authority in accordance with the published and posted rules to take any and all disciplinary actions which they deem reasonable and necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of all persons utilizing the pool facility, and/or to prevent injury to persons and/or damage to or destruction of property.
9. **Non-toilet trained individuals must wear a swim diaper.** If there is fecal contamination of the pool, all pools will be closed for 8 hours or until lifeguards deem safe to return.
10. Persons impaired by the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave.
11. Please do not allow children to play in or around the waterfall area next to the walkway entering the pool.
12. **Slide Rules:**
 - a. Slide use is at your own risk.
 - b. Slide use must be feet first.
 - c. If the water slide is turned off, it is closed.
 - d. No swimming is allowed in the slide area.
 - e. The steps located at this area are to be used only when exiting the pool after having used the slide.
 - f. No one is allowed to catch an individual inside the water as this is a proved safety hazard.
 - g. Weight limit for the slide is 200 lbs.
 - h. The slide is not intended to be used by pregnant women, persons with hearing, respiratory, neck, or back problems, or by persons who have undergone recent surgery or illness.
 - i. Only one person at a time may go down the slide, with the exception of an adult with a child 3 years and under.
